CAST MARBLE

Cast marble material is composed of natural mineral charges and resin. Surface of the material is coated with Gelcoat (800-1000 μ m) which provides optimal resistance and easy maintenance of the surface.

MAINTENANCE

In order to preserve the original characteristics of the surface, please follow the few short and simple rules of proper maintenance below.

EVERYDAY MAINTENANCE

The care of cast marble surfaces is quick and easy. To remove most stains, scale and dirt that can build up, simply clean the surface with a non-abrasive sponge and a normal non-abrasive detergent or other suitable product. Rinse the surface thoroughly after cleaning.

SUITABLE PRODUCTS

- AQUACLEAN Quando Acryl + glass
- · alcohol vinegar
- non-abrasive descaling agents
- cream or liquid detergents that do not contain microgranules that scrape the surface
- · denatured ethyl alcohol

UNSUITABLE PRODUCTS

- solvents such as acetone or trichlorethylene and other harsh chemicals
- aggressive chemicals such as hydrochloric acid or sodium hydroxide
- industrial cleaning products of unknown aggressiveness
- sink unclogging agents
- solvents used in the paint industry
- other aggressive substances such as thinners and the like

CLEANING

Wipe with a non-abrasive sponge or cloth and the usual non-abrasive bathroom detergent or other suitable product.

PREVENTION OF DAMAGE

Avoid using abrasive sponges and cleaning agents. Do not use metal scrapers.

The surface of cast marble is generally highly resistant to stains. In prolonged contact with the surface, certain substances such as paints, inks and cosmetic products can release colors onto the surface - try to ensure that such substances do not come into contact with the surface. Most stains can be removed using suitable cleaning products.

Avoid using unsuitable cleaning products.
